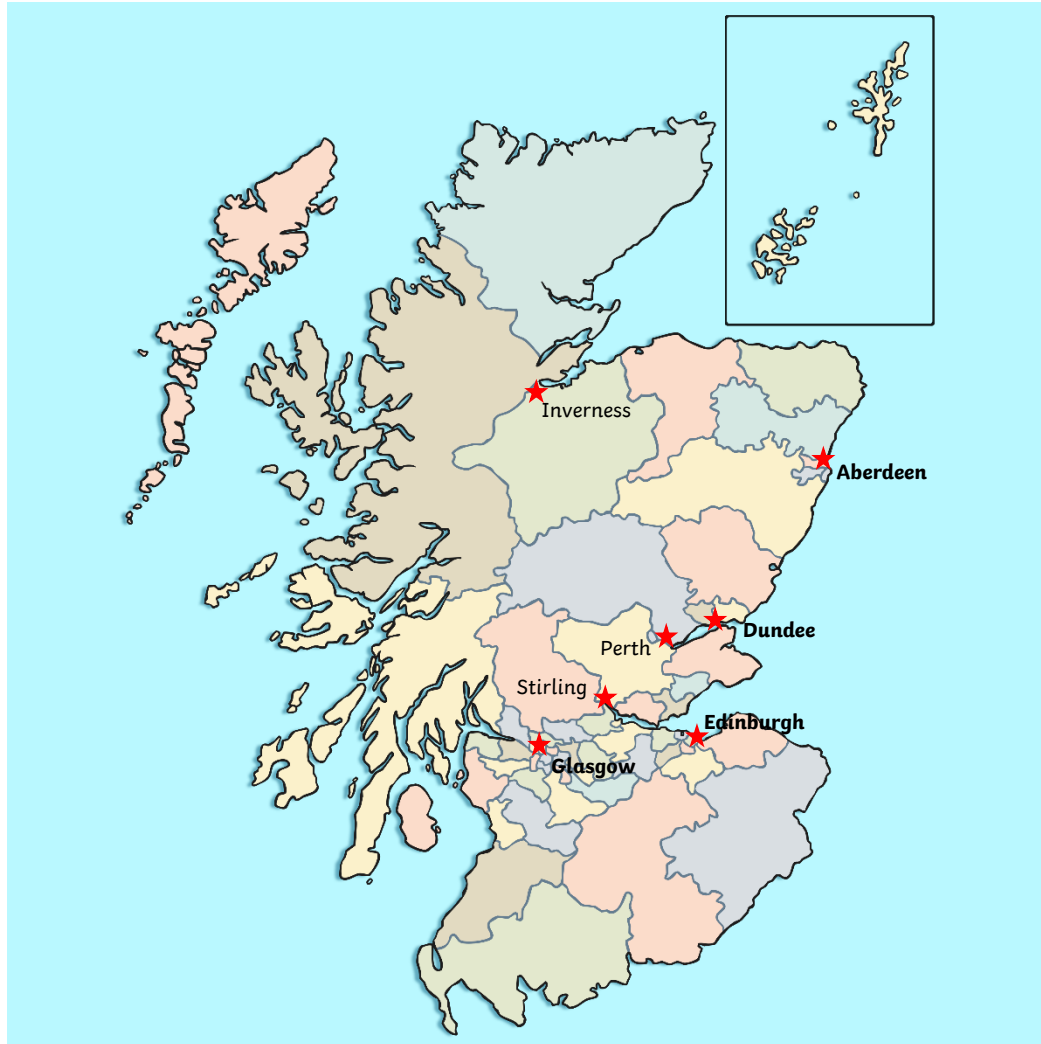

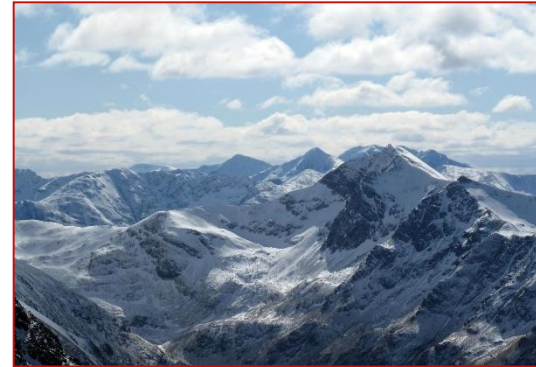


Landmarks in Scotland



Edinburgh Castle

Historic fortress situated on Castle Rock.



Ben Nevis

Located within the Grampian Mountains.
The tallest mountain in the British Isles.



Holyrood Palace

Official residence of the British monarch in Scotland.



Loch Ness

Huge, deep, freshwater loch in the Highlands.

River Tay

The longest river in Scotland.



Arthur's Seat

Main peak in a group of hills situated in the centre of Edinburgh.



Wallace Monument

A tower in Stirling to commemorate Sir William Wallace, a 13th century Scottish hero.
