



Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to the Autumn term, we hope you had a lovely summer! It is lovely to welcome back our year 13s and 14s and a warm welcome to our new year 12s. As usual, we have a busy term in The Student Centre with lots to look forward to and important goals to work towards for our pathways and NOCN accredited work.
