
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Beech Class for Term 1 2021-22

- Wellington boots and a raincoat as we move through into Winter
- A labelled water bottle and healthy snacks. We offer the children snack twice a day.
- A change of clothes in your child's bag in case of accidents and emergencies.
- If your child is currently wearing nappies, please ensure they are sent into school frequently, so we have some available each day. We will let you know through the home/school communication books if we are running low. In addition, we use standard wet wipes at the school so if your child has any skin sensitivities you may wish to send in some suitable wipes instead.

I would like to remind you **the importance of labelling your children's clothes**. Whilst we take every care to ensure children's clothing is put into the right bags, if the lovely new school jumpers and cardigans are not named, we cannot guarantee they will end up where they should be. **Please label all clothing** including trousers, spare clothes and PE kits.

If your child is absent from school for any reason please telephone on the first day of absence and send a letter in with your child on his/her return. If you have a medical appointment where possible please send in a copy of the appointment letter for the school's records.
