

Dear Parents/Carers/Guardians,

I hope you all enjoyed a lovely Easter break and welcome back for term 5.

Our topic for this term is Enchanted Forests. In English, we will be listening to a variety of fairy tales with a focus on Hansel and Gretel. In Maths, we will continue to develop our understanding of number as well as introduce early multiplication and division skills, and fractions.
