Changes to Speech and Language Therapist

Following the departure of the previous SALT, Rachel, we have a new SALT allocated to the school as of the start of this term. Her name is Emma Reed and she will be at Fitzwaryn on a weekly basis. Emma is being supported by a Technical Instructor, Paula Chester. We are, however, still short of a SALT but I have been informed that the managers of the service are doing all they can to recruit to the vacant post.

Illness and Attendance at School

We understand that from time-to-time pupils are unwell and need to stay at home to recover. Please can I remind you of the following:

- If your child has a high temperature they should stay at home and wait until it has passed before returning.

- If your child has had diarrhoea and/or vomiting please wait until 48 hours after the last bout of illness before they return to school.

- If your child has a runny nose, or a slight cough without a temperature and they can manage a day at school, then they should be at school.

- Good hand hygiene helps to stop the spread of viruses and we will be reinforcing this with pupils at school.

Gas Works along the Denchworth Road
