As we prepare our own lunch each day, the cost of this will continue to be £15.00 for a week (£3 per day) and this will also cover the cost of lunch out on special occasions (once we have more freedom!). **Please could you send in cash on a Monday morning.** You can also pay directly into the bank if this not convenient (We can let you know the bank details). **Please do not send in cheques as we are trying to avoid having to make visits to the bank.**

Given the current situation, we will not be going out into the community in term 1 (including shopping) and our curriculum will be making full use of the Student Centre and the school's facilities. As you can see on the timetable, all students will doing Horticulture on a Tuesday so please ensure that appropriate clothes and footwear are worn. Sport continues on a Wednesday afternoon and again full kit needs to be worn.
