

Fitzwaryn Remote Learning Plan

The following plan outlines how learning is continued in the following scenarios:

- 1. A pupil is well but self-isolating following a positive test in the household.
- 2. Pupils are well but self-isolating due to a case of COVID-19 within their bubble.
- 3. National lockdown is in place, including schools, and pupils are not in school.

The aim of the Fitzwaryn Remote Learning Plan is to ensure that learning can be continued regardless of lockdown or self-isolation and that the learning can be tailored to each individual's needs.

In the event of Scenarios 2 or 3 information will be loaded onto the 'Home Learning' section of the school website. The Class Teacher will call if a pupil is well but self-isolating and discuss with parents/carers the best format and level of support. In all Scenarios, resources such as stationary can be provided by the school if required.

Daily Timetable

Below is a suggested daily timetable. In the event of Scenarios 2 and 3 an example timetable will be provided for each key stage and a range of bespoke activities will be provided for each stage of the day from which an individualised timetable can be created, considering EHC plan outcomes.

Suggested Activities

Suggested activities for each stage of the timetable will be shared through the 'Home Learning' section of the school website. These will take various forms including practical activities, suggested Apps or websites, worksheets, or challenges. The activities will be loaded onto the website ready to be accessed each Monday.

Where required any logins or passwords will be shared with each pupil/family.

Communication with Class Teacher

Scenario 1

- The class teacher will complete a weekly phone call, via ZOOM if preferred. These phone calls will allow teachers and parents to share information and offer support.

Scenarios 2 and 3

- The class teacher will complete a weekly phone call.
- Weekly small group 'keeping in touch' ZOOM calls will be offered. The social focus of these
 allows the pupils to share what they have being doing at home and keep in touch with their
 friends.
- Twice weekly 'explanation sessions' will be offered for those that can access the sessions through ZOOM. The focus will be an explanation of the tasks set through the website and then providing the pupils with an opportunity to share what they have done. Where required a parent/carer may need to support their child in these sessions.

Assessment of Work

In all Scenarios, any work completed at home can be sent into the school, via email (office.7027@fitzwaryn.oxon.sch.uk) or by post and Class Teachers will endeavour to provide feedback through weekly communication.
