




Plan of a Church

Plan of a Church **Answers**

Children may choose to place the objects at different locations on the plan of the church building.

- *The lectern should be located in a visible place, perhaps at the front of the building rather than in the centre.*
- *The altar should be at the front of the building.*
- *The font should be placed near one of the doors.*
- *The Bible should be placed alongside the lectern.*

When explaining the shape of the church building, more able children should reference the shape of the building representing a cross. They might also make reference to the cross as an important Christian symbol and a reminder for Christians of Jesus.
