

English work – To be completed throughout the week.

I would really like you to keep a diary of your time at home. This week I want you to write a daily entry. You can either do this in a notebook of some kind (it must be lined and you must be able to bring it to school when lockdown is over) or you can type them and save. If you don't have a notebook then please let me know and we will get one sent out to you, you may just have to start your work a little bit later.

Each day I want you to focus on something new within in your writing:

Day 1	Capital letters and full stops - Don't forget to start each sentence with a capital letter and end each sentence with a full stop. Don't forget you need to use capital letters for words such as I and for names of people and places.
Day 2	Adverbs - Include some adverbs in your writing. Remember that they are used to describe an adjective! E.g. Charlotte ran around the track <u>quickly</u> .
Day 3	Time Connectives - I want you to use a range of time connectives within your writing. Some examples are: <u>before, after, then, next, shortly after</u>
Day 4	Revisit all the things we have focussed on over the last 2 weeks. - Handwriting - Capital letters and full stops - Connectives - Adverbs - Time Connectives
Day 5	

Within your diary entry, you could include:

- What you have been doing
- What have you eaten
- Have you spoken to any friends?
- How are you feeling?
